

Glacier View Ranch Facilities Available

Meeting Areas:

- **Conference Room**

The Conference Room is located on the third floor of the lodge. The Conference Room holds a maximum of 75 persons. The Conference Room is used for meetings, small group breakouts, visiting, refreshments, table games and other seated activities. No physically active games are permitted. The Lodge Kitchen located next to the Conference Room is a separate rental facility.

- **Long House**

The Long House is located in the middle of the main Ranch area. The Long House holds a maximum of 200 persons. The Long House has a kitchen in the back and a stage and fireplace in the front. The Long House is ideal for youth groups, active meetings, crafts, drama programs, gymnastics, or other active programs.

- **Auditorium/Chapel**

The Auditorium is located in the building next to the lodge. The Auditorium seats a maximum of 350 persons. The Auditorium has a platform at the front and a balcony (for sound equipment personnel) in the back. The Auditorium has pews that are fixed to the floor. It features a church setting and is ideal for large, less active group meetings. *No food, drink or gum is permitted in the Auditorium at any time. Candles may be used only with the permission of Guest Services.*

Recreation:

- **Swimming Pool & Hot Tubs**

1. Glacier View Ranch does not provide a lifeguard at any time for the pool. It is the Group Leader's responsibility to provide a lifeguard during the group's swimming activities. The recommended ratios for supervision are one lifeguard and/or lookout for every 10 persons. **No one is permitted to swim alone.**
2. A Glacier View Ranch staff member will meet your lifeguard at the pool prior to your pool time to unlock the pool and review the pool regulations. Failure to follow any of these regulations will result in your group being asked to leave the pool.
3. Pool towels for Lodge guests are located in the yellow container on the first floor landing of the lodge closest to the covered walkway. Pool towels must not be taken from the Lodge/Pool areas.
4. Cabin guests are required to bring their own towels.
5. Guests who are pregnant or have high blood pressure should consult their physician before using the hot tub. No one under the age of 18 is allowed in the hot tubs.

Lodging:

- **Lodge Rooms** - Rooms are available that sleep 1 – 4 persons (Quad rooms are 2 queen beds)
- **Youth Cabins** - Sleep 9 persons
- **Rustic Cabin** - Sleeps up to 7 persons

Camping:

- **RV Sites** (Some with electricity & some without electricity)
- **Tent Sites** (Designated areas where campfires are allowed)
- **Outback Camp Sites** (Designated for larger camping groups)
